Bibliographies & Catalogs Exercise

Instructions Note that the exercise will require manual updating for your score to be recorded.

Q1. Access the USF Libraries catalog basic search. Using African Queen as a search term, how many entries (hits) do you find for title, for subject heading, and by searching anywhere (keyword)?

Title – 3,072 Subject Heading – 489 Keyword – 81,039

Q2. Using the same searches as above, what are the results when you use enclose "African Queen" in quotes, indicating to search by a phrase? How do you explain the differences in the results?

Title – 2,166 Subject Heading – 436 Keyword – 49,339

When searching without quotation marks, the catalog retrieves titles that have either of the words "African" or "Queen." However, when quotation marks are included it only retrieves results that have both of those words together.
